The Gorsemoor Association (in consultation with staff) has organized a separate 'Leavers' disco on Thursday 6th July from 8.30 to 9.30pm for Year 6 pupils.

Year 6 pupils **MUST** queue on the playground outside KS2 doorway to enter (as the previous disco finishes at 8.30pm) but they will exit through the front of school in the usual way.

Our normal policy applies; all children must be collected promptly at the end of their disco by a responsible adult. Children will not be allowed to leave the Hall alone.



Our DJ will still play games with Year 6 so **NO** adults or other age children are invited as our discos are fully supervised by Staff and PTFA members. We will phone if your child needs you.

**Special Permission:** Year 6 may bring cameras and phones, for appropriate photos to be taken with the consent of each child in the picture. Remember school policy is that these images must **NOT** be distributed or placed online e.g. in social media. This is to protect our children (Year 6 pupils have been reminded of this rule).

Usual refreshments on sale priced from 1p to 20p. Please ensure that all money is kept in a safe pocket or named purse. **All food and drink must be consumed in the dining room:** for safety reasons they will not be permitted in the Hall.

Children will not be allowed to leave the Hall alone, unless Year 6 staff have written parental permission. Please make sure that your child knows how they are getting home. Please **EMPHASIZE** that they should **NOT** go outside without permission.
