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Dear Parent or Guardian

As some of you are aware, Gorsemoor is now using the online maths learning program, Mathletics. So, your child will have access to Mathletics at home and school through a unique username and password which will be given to them by their class teacher. This is very exciting time for us as the program has so much to offer to ALL ages in the school, with activities and challenges specifically set for your child's stage in their learning.

As maths has a huge focus at Gorsemoor, we recommend that you try to spend time looking at the program with your child to explore how Mathletics will benefit his or her learning. As a parent or guardian, you can also sign up to the Mathletics Family Centre. This will give you access to the learning content your child is following, and information regarding his or her progress within Mathletics. To register for this service, you will need your child's username and password: As mentioned above, these will be given out by your child's class teacher or stuck into their homework diaries. Then you will need to visit www.mathletics.com/parents < Complete the fields and click Register < then record your new username and password. To access the Mathletics Family Centre, visit www.mathletics.com < then sign in using your own username and password. You will find a link to the website under 'Maths' on our school website.

At school, pupils will be given the opportunity to participate in Mathletics activities during maths lessons, as well as some year groups allocating time before and after school as well as at lunch times. Year group teachers will be deciding on the availability of this provision and contacting parents accordingly. In the meantime, practise at home is encouraged. Teachers can also set homework tasks online - the normal Mathletics activities will then be blocked until the homework task has been completed. In addition to this, teachers can monitor and track pupils work/time spent completing games and activities. We hope that Mathletics encourages your child to enjoy maths whilst learning/practising new skills learned at school.
