
## Gorsemoor Primary School Funding 2016-2017: £88, 440\* Pupil Premium Spend 2016-2017



- Extra teacher in Year 5 to reduce set sizes
- Parent workshops to increase parental engagement
- Whole school 1:1 tuition
- Whole school small group intervention groups
- Additional 1:1 teacher to provide extra support to vulnerable pupils to 'narrow the gap'
- 'Catch up@' sessions to support Pupil Premium children in a range of skills across English and Maths
- Additional Teaching Assistant to provide Phonic and Maths intervention
- Continued contributions towards educational visits
- Continued extra curricula activities for Pupil Premium children
- Additional educational resources to support progress and 'narrowing the gap'
- Sound Training has been purchased and small group English intervention is taught through a specialist external teacher
- Time for SENCO and Pupil Premium leader to meet and monitor the progress of pupils
- A homework breakfast club will be run before school to support with the completion of homework
- Training and staff development in how to best support Pupil Premium children
- A part-time parent and pupil support worker will provide vital links and support between home and school
