Year Six Christmas Party Tuesday 19th December

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This is to give you some information regards our party day on Tuesday 19th December.

The children will not be required to come to school in school uniform on that day. However, bear in mind that they will be going out onto the yard at morning break time and at lunchtime so sensible clothing and footwear is a must!

The children are going to organise themselves into groups of 4 - 6 within the classes. As in previous years, we ask the children to kindly organise to bring snacks within their groups. This means that one child might bring in some savouries, another cakes, another crisps and another some fruit or vegetable nibbles. In this way we have avoided masses of waste and the children can enjoy their chosen food with their friends! They will eat their party food either early in the morning or later in the afternoon, so children will still need a normal packed lunch or hot dinner on that day.

We will provide paper plates and plastic cups and orange (sugar free) squash. Please be mindful that we do have children in the year group who are allergic to nuts and certain fruits, so we would ask that NOBODY brings in nuts, nut products or strawberries in all classes. The children may also bring in items to decorate the table, as in each class there will be a small prize for the most festive/imaginative table. There will also be a small prize for the healthiest table. Please can we ask that no confetti or party poppers are brought into school however, as these are difficult to clean up at the end of the day.

Your child will let you know which children they are grouped with and we suggest that you are able to liaise with them and their parents.
